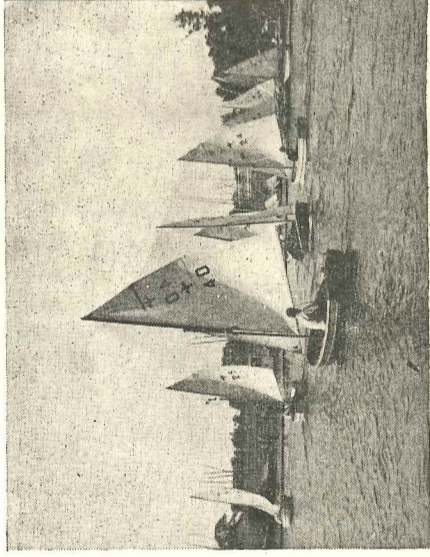

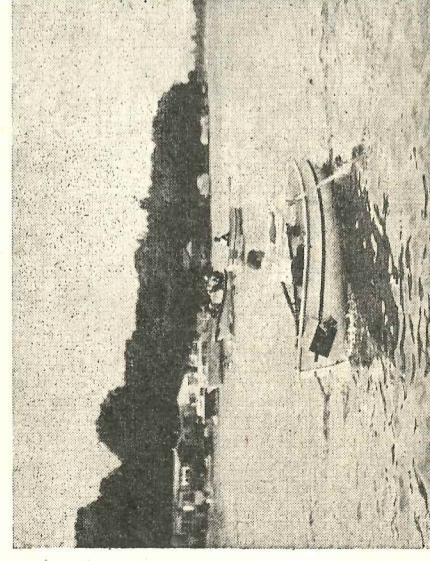

A fresh breeze speeds the entrants in a single handed dinghy sailing event.

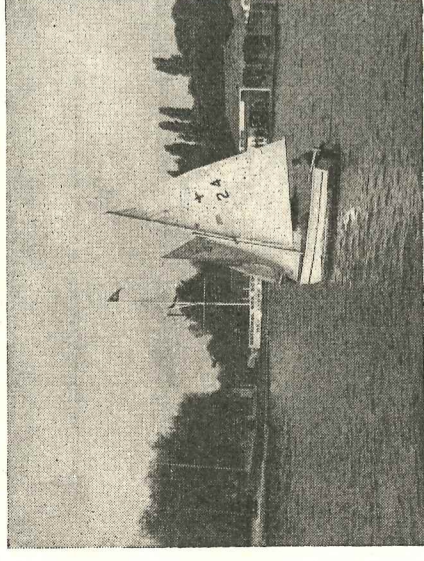

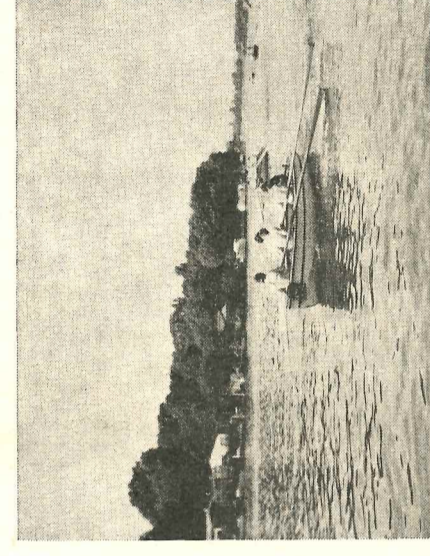
